Can I Vote Early?

First-time voters who registered by mail or registration drive may NOT vote by absentee ballot. Michigan residents may apply for an absentee ballot if they have a valid excuse, which includes expecting to be out of town on Election Day.

A voter can request and cast an absentee ballot at a municipal clerk's office up until November 5. Since this is in person, first-time voters may take advantage of this, regardless of how they registered.

Request an absentee ballot by mail by
2 p.m. November 4

What ID Do I Need to Vote?

You will be asked for photo ID when you vote. If you don't have one, you will sign an affidavit and vote a ballot that will be counted on Election Day. **IDs include:**

- A driver's license or ID card from Michigan or another state
- Student ID
- A passport
- A military ID with photo
